
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Driving with Dementia

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National Presence

- 21 states & NYC: Silver Alert
- 8 states: similar (other names)
- 9 states: broader criterion for missing persons (any age)
- 6 states: legislation pending
- 6 states: no legislation
- Federal Legislation: S. 1263 pending ...




Maryland

- Demographic growth (2000-2012)
 - 65+ licensed drivers: 12% drivers
 - Significant increase in 85+
- Incidence of Alzheimer's:
 - 86,000 age 65+ 2010
 - Increased by 10% since 2000
- Silver Alert:

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- Activated October 1, 2009
- Criterion based





Florida Silver Alert Experience

- Implemented 10/08
 - Criteria based
- Cases to Date:
 - 636 activations (240 denials)

- 77% men

Age range:

2012: mean=81

Recovery:

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- Same county: 43%

- Different county: 49%

Out of state: 8%



The Florida Sliver Alert Plan is a tool which aids local law enforcement in the recovery of a missing senior who suffers from an irreversible deterioration of intellectual faculties. The Plan provides for activation of a State Silver Aiert when a person meeting the criteria goes missing while driving a motor vehicle. Local agencies are encouraged to issue Local Silver Alerts for persons meeting the criteria when a vehicle is not involved. The following is a monthly report detailing State Silver Alerts issued by the FDLE Missing Endangered Persons Information Clearinghouse.

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

Recoveries: A direct recovery is defined as a person recovered due to the activation of the State Silver Alert, primarily through the use of dynamic highway message signs or other actions initiated by state agencies. An indirect recovery is defined as a person recovered through the actions of the local agency in coordination with the Silver Alert Plan, primarily through law enforcement communications or media. All listed recovery information is as of April 1, 2013.
