Application for Out-of-State Dealer Participating in Off-Site Vehicle Show

Under Maryland Vehicle Law, a new vehicle dealer, out-of-state dealer or a licensed vehicle salesman who is employed by the out-of-state dealer may participate in two (2) annual shows if the shows are limited to only Motor Homes and Recreational Trailers.

Instructions to the Out-of-State Dealer:

- All vehicle shows must have a Sponsor.
- The state in which the dealer is licensed must have reciprocity with Maryland. That state reciprocally authorizes Maryland dealers of motor homes and recreational trailers to display or exhibit motor homes or recreational trailers at vehicle shows in that state.
- The out-of-state dealer can only display or exhibit Motor Homes & Recreational Vehicles in Worcester County, MD. The dealer cannot accept a deposit or execute a buyer's order at the vehicle show in Worcester County.
- The out-of-state dealer must have a valid license in a state other than Maryland and obtain approval from the Maryland MVA at least 60 days before the show is held.
- A vehicle show may not exceed 10 consecutive days and is restricted to new vehicles only.
