UPDATED NOTICE

This notice repeals and replaces the April 2, 2020 and is given by Christine Nizer, Administrator of the Maryland Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Administration, acting pursuant to the Proclamation of Governor Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr. (the "Governor") dated March 5, 2020 proclaiming a state of emergency and a catastrophic health emergency related to COVID-19, as it may be amended or renewed from time to time, and the Order of the Governor dated March 12, 2020 entitled "Extending Certain Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Other Governmental Authorizations, and Authorizing Suspension of Legal Time Requirements", as it may be amended from time to time, after finding that the action(s) described herein will not endanger the public health, welfare, or safety.

The Maryland Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Administration will not process suspensions related to the following: Transportation Article §§16-206(a)(1)(iii), 16-206(a)(1)(iv), 16-206(a)(2), 16-206(a)(3), 16-206(c), 16-206.1, 16-213, 17-104(h), §17-106, 17-204, 17-209, 21-1128, 26-201, 26-204, 27-103, 26-206, 27-103, CR § 10-110, CJP §3-8A-19. Any effect of those listed above inconsistent for the foregoing is hereby suspended.

**This Notice is effective immediately and may, at the discretion of the Administrator and to the extent it will not endanger public health, welfare, or safety, continue until no later than 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date by which the state of emergency is terminated and the catastrophic health emergency is rescinded.**
