RE: Disclosure of Former Vehicle Use

Disclosure of Former Vehicle Use

As a reminder and in accordance with Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 11.12.01.14 M, Disclosure of Former Vehicle Use:

- (1) Vehicles formerly used for a purpose other than a consumer good shall be clearly and conspicuously identified as to their former use. This includes, but is not limited to, vehicles formerly used:
 - (a) For public or governmental purposes and normally driven by multiple drivers;
 - (b) As executive driven vehicles;
 - (c) As demonstrators
 - (d) For driver training;
 - (e) As taxicabs; or
 - (f) As short-term rental vehicles.
- (2) The word “commercial”, or similar ambiguous terms, may not be used to describe these vehicles.

The regulations do not state this disclosure must be made on the buyers order. Therefore, the disclosure may be on a separate document.
