RE: Driver Improvement Program Instructor Training Schedule 2020

Completion of a Maryland approved Driver Improvement Program (DIP) is required of individuals accumulating a specific number of points on their Maryland driving record, as a result of an order issued by a district court or administrative law judge, or as part of the license reinstatement process.

Persons seeking approval to teach the Maryland DIP are required to complete the training program offered by the MDOTMVA. The training program is offered every other month and is a two-day training program. The schedule for training classes in 2020 is as follows:

January 30 & 31	July 23 & 24
March 26 & 27	September 24 & 25
May 21 & 22	November 19 & 20

All classes will be conducted in classroom 4, on the ground floor of the MVA headquarters building in Glen Burnie. Admittance to the classroom will begin at 8:30 am when the building opens and class will commence promptly at 9:00 am. No one will be admitted to the class after 9:15 am.

In the event that a change of venue is necessary for any class, registrants will be notified via email.

In the event of inclement weather, the classes will follow the status of Anne Arundel County Public Schools. If the Anne Arundel County Public Schools are closed, classes will be cancelled.
