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I/we do hereby make application for class "Q" Limousine plates and title for the above described vehicle. The undersigned certifies that the vehicle has been modified or stretched for the transportation of passengers; and is equipped with amenities not normally provided in passenger cars, including a custom interior, television, video cassette recorder, musical sound system, telephone, ice storage area, additional interior lighting and driver-passenger communication, such as an intercom or power-operated driver partition.

- Vehicles registered after May 1, 1999 may not exceed thirty five (35) feet in length and must meet or exceed all federal safety standards after alteration or modification of the original vehicle design.
- Vehicles designed/modified to carry sixteen (16) or more passengers, including the driver, or are rated, registered or operating with a GVW of 10,000 lbs. or more, must comply with 49 CFR, Parts 390 through 399 . The operator of a vehicle designed/modified to carry 16 or more passengers, including the driver, must comply with the commercial driver's licensing requirements and any other requirements defined in Article 25-111 of the Transportation Article.

Article Transportation 21-1127, effective June 1, 2021:

- An individual may not operate for hire a Motor Vehicle designed to carry 15 or fewer passengers, including the driver, unless the individual holds a valid for-hire driver's license or Transportation Network Operator's License issued by the Public Service Commission or the Appropriate Local authority, and;
- A person may not allow an individual to operate a Motor Vehicle designed to carry 15 or fewer passengers, including the driver, unless the individual operating the Motor Vehicle holds a valid for-hire driver license or Transportation Network Operator's License issued by the Public Service Commission or the Appropriate Local authority.
- A person convicted of a violation of this section is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 1 year, or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both.
