Criteria for Alcohol/Drug Restriction Removal

Alcohol/Drug Restriction 1 – A customer with none or 1 alcohol/drug related incident within 5 current years may inquire about having an alcohol/drug restriction removed **one year** from the date the restriction was imposed provided the customer: (1) Held a valid driver license for a minimum of one year; and, (2) Has not been involved in any alcohol/drug incidents during the period; and (3) Does not have any pending alcohol/drug related charges.

Alcohol/Drug Restriction 2 – A customer with 2 alcohol/drug related incidents within 5 current years may inquire about having an alcohol/drug restriction removed **three years** from the date the restriction was imposed, provided the customer: (1) Held a valid driver license for a minimum of one year; and, (2) Has not been involved in any alcohol/drug incidents during the period; and (3) Does not have any pending alcohol/drug related charges.

Alcohol/Drug Restriction 3 – A customer with 3 or more alcohol/drug related incidents within 5 current years or drug related incident involving a fatality may inquire about having an alcohol/drug restriction removed **five years** from the date the restriction was imposed, provided the customer: (1) Held a valid driver license for a minimum of one year; and, (2) Has not been involved in any alcohol/drug incidents during the period; and (3) Does not have any pending alcohol/drug related charges.
