Please be advised, the Motor Vehicle Administration has been made aware of fraudulent Maryland Vehicle Inspection Reports being submitted for title transactions.

Effective immediately, if you receive a Maryland State Vehicle Inspection Report (Sample attached) you must verify the inspection via Maryland State Police e-Inspection search website at the following address: <u>https://egov.maryland.gov/msp/vsi/Lookup#/</u>.

To view results of an inspection, input the full VIN # or the last 7 digits of the VIN# in the Vehicle VIN search field. The below inspection information will be returned for a passed inspection. The valid inspections that have a Pass result must be submitted with your title transaction.



If you receive the message "Your search did not find any results, please modify your search and try again," do not accept the Vehicle Inspection Report, reject the transaction, and have the customer return to the inspection station.
