RE:	MDOT MVA Announces Statewide Branch Office Closure in Response to COVID-19

To preserve the health and safety of customers and employees, the Maryland Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Administration (MDOT MVA) will close all branch offices statewide at 4:30 today. This operational change, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, is effective immediately and until further notice.

All previously scheduled appointments are cancelled. Customers will receive correspondence when branch offices re-open and appointments are available again.

Governor Hogan has ordered an <u>extension of all driver's and business licensed, identification cards, permits, registrations</u> with expiration dates beginning March 12 until the end of the state of emergency. As a result, they will not expire until 30 days after the state of emergency has been lifted.
