RE: Revised Bond Requirement

Effective October 1, 2018, HB 1065 Vehicle Laws – Title Service Agents affects the surety bond amount requirement and the ability to retain a percentage of the excise tax collected for title transactions.

As a result of this bill:

- The surety bond amount required for title services will be increased from \$25,000 to \$50,000 per business. <u>The increased bond amount of \$50,000 must be in effect no</u> <u>later than October 1, 2018.</u>
- 2. A title service agent that, on behalf of the Administration, collects and remits the vehicle excise tax imposed may keep the lesser of \$12 per vehicle or 0.6% of the gross excise tax that the title service agent collects.
- 3. The bill also provides that if a title service fails to pay the appropriate excise tax for each title transaction, the administration may levy, in addition to the tax and assessment, a penalty equal to 25% of the tax due.
